

LONG IRONS AND HYBRID CLUBS

Many sets you will find now, especially for kids and women, come with hybrid clubs. This is a club that gives you the same distance as a long iron, but is easier to hit than a long iron. Long irons are considered to be 1 thru 6 irons, although most sets start with a 3 iron.

- For long irons and hybrid clubs you should move the ball forward just a bit in your stance. A good gauge would be to move the ball one or 1 ½ ball lengths forward.
- Be sure to make a smooth stroke. Stay within your normal swing speed and allow the club to do the work. Swinging harder will usually result in a poor shot.
- If you feel like the club you have in your hand will not go far enough then take one more club and swing more smoothly.
